

Why purchase authentic wood flooring rather than 'prefinished' or 'engineered' products?

Authentic wood floors are solid wood and perfectly flat with no grooves to collect dirt. They are the same as the finest wood floors have been for hundreds of years. They can be refinished several times over the next hundred years, restoring their new condition each time.

Authentic wood floors are laid by experienced installers, then sanded and finished with one of several excellent floor finishes (ask us about how to select an installer and an appropriate finish).

Although the process of installing and finishing an authentic wood floor is more involved than with a 'prefinished' floor, the quality of the final product is far superior—and the cost usually is not greater.

You see, 'prefinished' floors have a v-joint between the floor boards, which collects dirt every time you sweep the floor and gradually accumulates grime over time. An even greater problem arises when, after a few years, you have to 'refinish' the floor. You can sand the flat surfaces but you can't get at those pesky grooves unless you sand off enough wood to get to the bottom of the grooves, in which case you lose a lot of the thickness in your floor. This effectively prevents you from ever getting a 'like-new' job when your finish begins to wear.

Of course, an authentic wood floor looks and feels like real wood, because there is no layer of plastic between you and your floor.

For all of these reasons, and others you may discover, it makes good sense to select authentic wood flooring for your home.
