Why purchase tamarack decking rather than treated wood or plastic decking?

1. Tamarack, also called Hackmatack or Larch, is a local wood which is highly resistant to decay. In fact, it is more long lasting than 'treated' lumber, even if the 'treated' lumber has not been cut off or trimmed. This is because tamarack has natural antibacterial properties all through the wood. 'Treated' lumber only has a layer of toxic chemicals on the outside surface. As soon as the wood under that layer of chemicals has been exposed, rot can get right into the wood.
2. 'Treated' decking is highly toxic, especially to children and wildlife. In fact, it has been banned in some jurisdictions. Tamarack decking is a natural wood product, completely safe for use on any surface around the home.
3. Tamarack decking is beautiful, displaying its natural woodiness, whereas 'treated' decking looks like it has been dipped in green chemicals, which it has.
4. Surprisingly, tamarack decking usually is not more expensive than 'treated' decking.
5. As for plastic decking, it is very durable and long-lasting. In fact, it will hang around in the environment for a very long time—long after you, your house, and your deck are gone. It is not biodegradable, which eventually may cause a big environmental problem.
6. Plastic decking also is much more expensive than tamarack decking.
